Volunteer to various organizations during retirement Daniel A. Kelley, 85, of Fayetteville, died Feb. 13, 2006 at St. Joseph's Hospital. A native of Syracuse, he graduated from St. Anthony's, CBA, Notre Dame University in 1941, and the Naval Academy at Harvard graduating as a Lieutenant JG. He spent five years in the Navy aboard the USS Muliphen. Upon his return home, he assumed ownership of his father's insurance company, the George B.G. Kelley Co. and in later years merged with Haylor-Fryer-Coon Agency. Upon retirement he spent time volunteering; 12 years at St. Camillus Rehabilitation Center, five years at Community General Hospital, served five years on the Fayetteville-Manlius School Board, was a driver for FISH and served as president and driver for F-M Meals on Wheels for 15 years. He was past president of the Onondaga County Insurance Agents Association, past president of CNY Notre Dame Club, past board member of the NY State Conservative Party, former member of Bellvue Country Club and Cavalry Golf Club, and a 60-year member of American Legion Post 41. Surviving are his wife of 55 years, Milrita; a daughter and son-in-law, Marita Kelley-Dimon and Ken Dimon; two grandchildren, Cassidy and Dalton; two brothers, Dick (Mary Grace) Kelley and Phil (Tommy) Kelley; two sisters-in-law, Pat Hogan and Nancy Hogan and many nieces and nephews. Funeral services were held at Eaton-Tubbs-Schepp Funeral Home and at Immaculate Conception Church, Fayetteville. Burial was in Immaculate Conception Cemetery.
