

Martin G. Koloski, retired general surgeon, New Smyrna Beach, Fla., on October 17, 2006. Born on Staten Island, Koloski moved to Florida in 1993 from Poughkeepsie, N.Y., where he lived for 43 years. He received his medical training at Downstate Medical Center of New York State University, interned at the Brooklyn Hospital and had his surgical residency at Nassau Hospital. Koloski served two years in the Navy as the ship physician on the USS *Muliphen*. He was chairman of the department of surgery, president of the medical staff and the president of the Dutchess County Medical Society. Koloski was on the board of Blue Cross/Blue Shield and the upstate chapter of the American College of Surgeons and was on the staff of Vassar Hospital and St. Francis Hospital for 35 years.
